

A MUNICIPAL MAYOR'S COURT COMPUTER FUND,
ORDINANCE No. SECTION 133.093, FOR THE VILLAGE OF ST. PARIS,
AND DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Section 5705.12 of the Ohio Revised Code allows the establishment of special funds, subject to approval of the Auditor of State; and

WHEREAS, money derived from specified sources may be paid directly into such funds; and

WHEREAS, the Administration has recommended, and this Council deems it appropriate to establish such fund for the purpose of paying the costs of a computer for the Mayor's Court; and

WHEREAS, it is prudent to begin collection of this fee, beginning April 2004, all for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF ST. PARIS, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 133.093, Municipal Mayor's Court Computer Fund, of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of St. Paris is hereby created as follows:

133.096 MUNICIPAL MAYORS'S COURT COMPUTER FUND
There is hereby created a Municipal Mayor's Court Computer Fund into which shall be deposited cash or proceeds from cases heard in the Village of St. Paris Municipal Mayor's Court.

Proceeds received hereunder are designated by Council to be used only for payment for the court computer and for any updates or maintenance required therefore.

Section 2. That Chapter 133, Department of Finance, of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of St. Paris, is hereby amended to reflect this newly created fund.

Section 3. That for reasons set forth in the preamble hereinabove, this ordinance is declared emergency legislation and shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage by this Council and approval of the Mayor.
