ORDINANCE # 860

**AN ORDINANCE TO REQUIRE THE REMOVAL OF DOG EXCREMENT**


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF SAINT PARIS, OHIO:

SECTION 1. No person shall allow a dog under his or her control to be upon property or upon the property of another, absent the consent of the owner or occupant of the property, without some device for the removal and containment of such dog's excrement; nor shall any person fail to remove immediately any excrement deposited by any dog under his or her control on public or private property.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall not apply to guide dogs under the control of a blind person.

SECTION 3. Whoever violates this ordinance is guilty of a minor misdemeanor.


SECTION 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and a measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall go into affect forthwith. The reason for said emergency is the necessity to ensure the cleanliness of public and private property.
