AN ORDINANCE FOR THE CONTROL OF DOGS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 955 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF ST. PARIS, OHIO THAT

SECTION I. In accordance with Chapter 955 of the Ohio Revised code, it is unlawful:

- ≯ For the owner, custodian, or keeper to own, keep, harbor or provide breed dogs are to: custodians or keepers of dangerous or vicious dogs, as described in the months of age.
