the salary of the Village Fiscal Officer shall be established upon the appointment of said position are hereby combined and there is hereby created the position of the Village Fiscal Officer, and In accordance with Section 733.262 of the Ohio Revised code, the duties of Clerk and Treasurer

The Village Fiscal Officer shall have the powers, duties, and functions as provided by the general

SECTION II. laws of the State of Ohio

SECTION III after the appointment takes effect, unless an ordinance is passed approving the Fiscal Officer's residence outside of the village. appointment; however, the Fiscal Officer shall become a resident of the village within six months not become effective until it is approved by a majority vote of the village legislative authority. Village Fiscal Officer need not be an elector of the village or reside in the village at the time of A Village Fiscal Officer shall be appointed by the mayor of the village, but that appointment doe

The Village Fiscal Officer may be removed without cause either by the mayor with the consent of a majority of the members of the village legislative authority or by a three-fourths vote of the village legislative authority with or without the consent of the mayor

SECTION IV. shall range from \$18,000 to \$32,000 per year, dependent upon performance and/or experience The Village Fiscal Officer shall work 32-40 hours per week. The salary of the Village Fiscal Officer Other benefits, to include, annual wage increases, shall be negotialed

SECTION V. completed and signed by both parlies; and be reviewed yearly An employment contract between the Village and The Fiscal Officer shall include provisions

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from the earliest period allowed by law
