SENIOR WATCH PROGRAM

St. Paris Police Department

FALL CLEAN-UP 2019

September - October

Fall Clean-up will be on Monday, October 14, 2019. Please place all yard debris near the curb. The Village will begin picking up Fall leaves during the month of November. Please rake your leaves to the curb. If you would like to bag your leaves for pick up, the Village has large leaf bags for \$2 per bag at the Municipal Building.

ST. PARIS ORDINANCE #904

Passed July, 2019

St. Paris Village Council passed an ordinance prohibiting disposal of leaves, grass and other waste matter into storm sewers within the Village of St. Paris, Ohio.

Ordinance #904 is hereby established, containing the following provisions:

- a) No person shall dispose or discharge waste matter including, but not limited to, leaves, grass clippings, waste oil or other non-aqueous materials into the street.
- b) Failure to comply with this section shall be deemed a minor misdemeanor, and each day of non-compliance shall be deemed a separate offense.
- c) A third violation of this section, charged within a two-year period as measured from the conviction date of the first offense, shall be deemed a third degree misdemeanor.

SUMMER METER PROGRAM

All Summer Meters Are Due Back November 1, 2019

If you have checked out a summer water meter from the St. Paris Municipal Building, your meter is due November 1, 2019. Your sewer account will be credited for the gallons of water you used that did not go through the St. Paris sewer system. The time to check them back out again will be April or May.

MOSQUITO SPRAYING

Organic, Garlic Based Spray

St. Paris has the Village sprayed for Mosquitoes every other Wednesday throughout the summer by A1 Able Pest Control. A1 Able uses an organic, chemical free spray that is garlic based. The Mosquito Spraying for the remainder of the year will be as follows: August 14 & 28, September 11 & 25, and October 9.

ST. PARIS WATER TREATMENT PLANT

Completed August 2018

St. Paris Water Treatment Plant has been up and running since August 2018. The treatment plant filters the water to remove iron and manganese then softens it to 10 grains. Previously the water came into your home with a hardness of 21 grains. If you have a water softener and want to soften your water to zero grains, you should adjust the softener accordingly. For any questions, you should contact your water softener's manufacturer.
