SUMMER METER PROGRAM

It's Time to Check-out Your Summer Meter

If you find yourself outside all summer running the garden hose, you may want to rent a summer meter to save on your sewer bills. The meter measures your outside water usage through your garden hose. Since this water does not run through your sewer system, the measured portion is deducted from your sewer bill. Meters are checked out by visiting the Municipal Building at 135 W. Main between the hours of 8:00 am – 4:00 pm. Meters are due back on or before November 1, then your savings will be calculated. The rental cost is \$10 per meter for the entire season.

ST. PARIS ORDINANCE #904

Passed July, 2019

St. Paris Village Council passed an ordinance prohibiting disposal of leaves, grass and other waste matter into storm sewers within the Village of St. Paris, Ohio.

Ordinance #904 is hereby established, containing the following provisions:

- a) No person shall dispose or discharge waste matter including, but not limited to, leaves, grass clippings, waste oil or other non-aqueous materials into the street.
- b) Failure to comply with this section shall be deemed a minor misdemeanor, and each day of non-compliance shall be deemed a separate offense.
- c) A third violation of this section, charged within a two-year period as measured from the conviction date of the first offense, shall be deemed a third degree misdemeanor.

Generally, the rain date is the following day.
