

Ordinance No. # 16-901 Passed 19

**AN ORDINANCE VACATING ALLEYS IN THE
ORIGINAL PLAT
OF THE VILLAGE OF ST. PARIS, OH, CHAMPAIGN COUNTY**

THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of St. Paris, OH, Champaign County:

SECTION 1: To vacate the following 10 foot alleys in the Batdorf Addition to the Village of St. Paris, as recorded in Plat Slide 294, Cabinet 1, of the Champaign County Plat Records as described:

1. A 10' wide Alley between lots four (4) and five (5) and lots twenty six (26) and twenty seven (27).
2. A 10' wide Alley between lots six (6) and seven (7) and lots twenty four (24) and lots twenty five (25).
3. A 10' wide Alley between lots eight (8) and nine (9) and lots twenty two (22) and twenty three (23).
4. A 10' wide Alley between lots eighteen (18) and nineteen (19).
5. St. Claire Ave. (46 ft. wide) between lots twenty (20) and twenty one (21).


SECTION 2: The retention of an easement for public utilities is reserved to the Village of St. Paris.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately as an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of health, safety and welfare of the general public within the Village of St. Paris and take precedence over any other previous Ordinance in reference to the above described alleys and will take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of St. Paris, OH, Champaign County upon the affirmative vote of all elected members of said Council, that Council adopt the foregoing Ordinance.
