AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A STATEMENT OF SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED TO 21.362 ACRES IN JOHNSON TOWNSHIP PROPOSED FOR ANNEXATION TO THE VILLAGE OF ST. PARIS, OHIO.

WHEREAS, Champaign County Commissioners have petitioned for annexation to the Village of St. Paris, certain real estate in Johnson Township designated in Exhibit "A" hereto;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 709.031, Ohio Revised Code, the Village Council is required to adopt a statement indicating what services, if any, the Village of St. Paris will provide to the territory proposed for annexation;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF ST. PARIS, OHIO:

SECTION I: That, with respect to the territory proposed for annexation aforesaid, the Village of St. Paris will provide such services as are otherwise provided to incorporated areas of this Village in accordance with applicable contemporary law, practice, custom, regulation and resources. The services of the Village of St. Paris currently include, but are not limited to, police, fire, ambulance, repair and maintenance of publicly dedicated streets, zoning, access to existing municipal water and sewer lines and services as well as general municipal government.

SECTION II: This ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare. The reason for such necessity is that the project authorized by this ordinance will be of great benefit to the municipality. Therefore, this ordinance shall go into immediate effect.

This Ordinance passed and adopted by the Council of the Village of St. Paris, OH, Champaign County, this 14th day of October, 2009.
