

**PRELIMINARY LEGISLATION – Village Consent**

The following is Ordinance/Resolution enacted by the Village of St. Paris, Champaign County, Ohio, hereinafter referred to as the Local Public Agency (LPA), in the matter of the stated described project.

**SECTION I - Project Description**

WHEREAS, the STATE has identified the need for the described project:

Micro surface the existing roadway for preventative maintenance on State Route 235 Straight Line Mile 0.00 to Straight Line Mile 6.59 with part residing within the Village of St. Paris, Champaign County, Ohio. Said project is further identified as **D07 MICRO PM FY17**.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Village of St. Paris, Ohio.

**SECTION II - Consent Statement**

Being in the public interest, the LPA gives consent to the Director of Transportation to complete the above described project.

**SECTION III - Cooperation Statement**

The LPA shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation in the above described project as follows:

ODOT shall assume and bear One-Hundred Percent (100%) of the necessary costs of the State's highways improvement project from funds allocated by the Federal Highway Administration, U.S. Department of Transportation. In the event that the Village requests certain features or appurtenances be included within the State's highway improvement project, and which features and appurtenances are determined by the State and Federal Highway Administration to be unnecessary for the State's project, the Village shall contribute One-Hundred Percent (100%) of the cost of those items.

If curb ramps are constructed by ODOT in compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act, future maintenance of installed sidewalk curb ramps shall be the responsibility of the Village. The Village shall adjust any existing castings, as required, with Village forces.

**SECTION IV - Utilities and Right-of-Way Statement**

The LPA agrees that all right-of-way required for the described project will be acquired and/or made available in accordance with current State and Federal regulations. The LPA also understands that right-of-way costs include eligible utility costs.

The LPA agrees that all utility accommodation, relocation and reimbursement will comply with the current provisions of 23 CFR 645 and the ODOT Utilities Manual.

**SECTION V - Maintenance**

Upon completion of the Project, and unless otherwise agreed, the LPA shall: (1) provide adequate maintenance for the Project in accordance with all applicable state and federal law, including, but not limited to, Title 23, U.S.C. Section 116; (2) provide ample financial provisions, as necessary, for such maintenance of the described Project; (3) maintain the right-of-way, keeping it free of obstructions; and, (4) hold said right-of-way inviolate for public highway purposes.

**SECTION VI - Authority to Sign**

The Village Administrator of said Village of St. Paris is hereby empowered on behalf of the Village of St. Paris to enter into contracts with the Director of Transportation necessary to complete the above described project.
