

Ordinance No. **868 Amended***Passed*

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE POSITION OF VILLAGE FISCAL OFFICER IN ACCOORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 733.262 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE.

WHEREAS; when there is a Clerk and Treasurer, upon resignations and/or 105 days before the general municipal election for a new term for the Clerk and Treasurer, Section 733.262 of the Ohio Revised Code empowers the Council to combine the positions and to create a position of the Village Fiscal Officer, and

WHEREAS; it is the judgment of this Council that the interests of the citizens of the Village of Saint Paris will be better served through the creation of the position of the Village Fiscal Officer;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF ST. PARIS, OHIO THAT

SECTION I. In accordance with Section 733.262 of the Ohio Revised code, the duties of Clerk and Treasurer are hereby combined and there is hereby created the position of the Village Fiscal Officer, and the salary of the Village Fiscal Officer shall be established upon the appointment of said position.

SECTION II. The Village Fiscal Officer shall have the powers, duties, and functions as provided by the general laws of the State of Ohio.

SECTION III. A Village Fiscal Officer shall be appointed by the mayor of the village, but that appointment does not become effective until it is approved by a majority vote of the village legislative authority. The Village Fiscal Officer need not be an elector of the village or reside in the village.

The Village Fiscal Officer may be removed without cause either by the mayor with the consent of a majority of the members of the village legislative authority or by a three-fourths vote of the village legislative authority with or without the consent of the mayor.


SECTION IV. The salary and work hours of the Village Fiscal Officer shall be negotiated by the Mayor and Administrator, with Council approval, dependent upon performance and/or experience. Other benefits, to include annual wage increases, shall be negotiated by the Mayor and Administrator with Council approval.

SECTION V. This Ordinance shall be an emergency measure necessary to protect the health, safety, welfare, and fiscal integrity of the citizens of the Village of Saint Paris

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from the earliest period allowed by law.


